Tasting Notes:

The 2005 Morisoli Cabernet is dark crimson-colored with an equally deep nose of mushrooms, densely textured earth, cassis, and blackberries along with its ubiquitous graphite and cedar. On the palate, this full-bodied wine shows focused flavors of cassis, wild blackberries, and dark plums accented by dusty earth and crushed stone. It finishes with vibrant fruit flavors, silky tannins, and underlying oak nuances. True to form, it displays the power and elegance that is so characteristic of this vineyard.

Enjoy with rich meat dishes and cheeses.

We recommend decanting and allowing to rest ahead of service if intending to drink within two years of the release date. You should otherwise feel comfortable cellaring this wine for 15 – 20 years.
