NAPA VALLEY**

Grape Source: Hayne Vineyard
Blend: 88% Petite Sirah and 12% Zinfandel
Harvest Brix: 27.0° and 25.2°
Maceration: 15 days non-inoculated
Aging: 10 ½ months in American Oak (90% new)
pH: 3.88
TA: 0.56 g/100ml
Alcohol: 14.6%
Production: 176 cases (12 pack – 750ml)
Release Date: January 2009

Tasting Notes:

The 2007 Hayne Petite Sirah has a dark purplish black color with an intense nose of ripe cherry, mocha, smoked bacon, lavender, cinnamon and an intriguing hint of earthy mushroom and dried herbs. Bright Bing cherry, raspberry and wild plum flavors lead to hints of dried orange peel, baking spice, pepper and chocolate. The wine has a lush mouthfeel with sleek balance of acidity, fruit and chewy tannins that lead to a long finish that seems to keep rolling over the palate.

Pair with lamb shank, wild game, veal, beef or strong cheeses.

Allow this wine plenty of air, it is drinking wonderfully right now but will continue to age well for the next 6 to 9 years.
