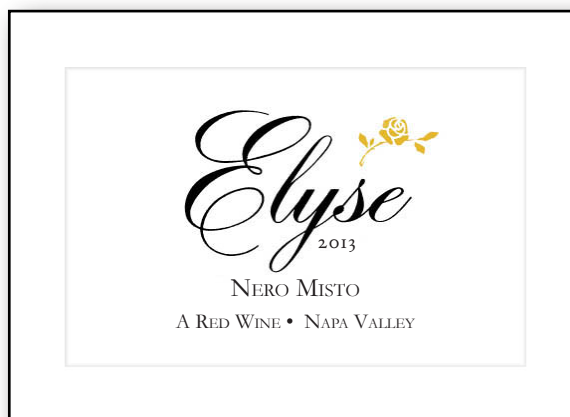

### TASTING NOTES:

As in vintages past, the 2013 Nero Misto (Italian for “Mixed Black”) is like a hippo on a tightrope: big, bodacious, and above all, balanced. This wine is ruby purplish in color with aromas of wild black fruits, sage and baking spice. It is medium to full-bodied and lushly textured with deep juicy flavors of mixed berry and pomegranate along with subtle notes of licorice, black pepper and Asian spice. This homage to the Cal-Ital blends of early Napa is as simple or complex as you would like and is truly such a purely enjoyable wine!

Nero Misto is extremely versatile, particularly good with Italian food, spicy southwest cuisine and steaks and chops off the grill. It is also spot on with a great hamburger or pizza.

Drinking beautifully right now, so why wait? (Although putting a bit down will be a nice surprise 5 - 7 years from now).
