TASTING NOTES:

Like a hippo on a tightrope, the 2014 Nero Misto (Italian for “Mixed Black”) is big, bodacious, and above all, balanced. Dark purple in color and with a spicy nose of wild black fruits, rose petals, plums and earth, this homage to the Cal-Ital blends of early Napa is a serious red wine. The palate reveals a full and round mouthfeel with ripe berry flavors and an amazing balance of fruit, tannin, and sweet oak.

Nero Misto is an extremely versatile wine, particularly good with Italian food, spicy southwest cuisine and steaks and chops off the grill. It is also spot on with a great hamburger or pizza.

Drinking beautifully right now, so why wait?
(Although putting a bit down will be a nice surprise 5 - 7
years from now).
