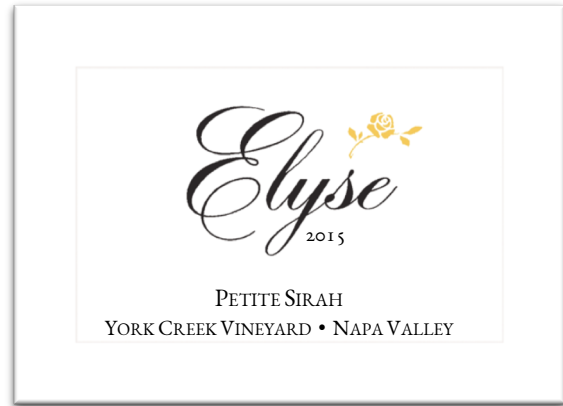

TASTING NOTES:

Our 2015 Petite Sirah is dark indigo in color and is alive with aromas of wild black fruit, baking spices, toasted wheat bread, and coffee. Its well-structured body is massively textured while retaining balance and a sense of elegance. Firm, chewy tannins come along with plum, blackberry, nutmeg, and vanilla flavors leading to a long and satisfying finish.

VINEYARD:

York Creek Vineyard, named for the defining feature of the land that flows year round through the property, is located high atop the Mayacamas range of mountains on the western edge of Napa Valley north of St. Helena. Perched at 1250 – 1800 feet above sea level with well-drained soil, its unique position in the Spring Mountain District is well known for producing dark and intensely flavored wines enables the grapes to mature slowly and retain their acidity and balance.



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
